PRIVACY POLICY

Based on Article. 20 clause 1 of the Act of 18 July 2002 on the provision of electronic services and on the basis of REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on free movement such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation - GDPR).

§ 1

The Privacy Policy sets out the terms and conditions:

- 1. processing of personal data,
- 2. storing information on User's devices using Cookies, which will be used to provide electronic services, access to information on the User's devices using Cookies, which will be used to provide electronic services.

§ 2

definitions

- 1. Nire means the Seller and the owner of the Nire Limited Liability Company website based in Cologne Mrokowska (05-552) at ul. Rejonowa 29, NIP 8442364341. 16. Cookies so-called cookies, mean IT data, primarily small text files, saved and stored on devices via which the User uses websites.
- 2. Website means www.nire.eu
- 3. Device means an electronic device through which the User gains access to the Website. 4. User is an entity for which services may be provided electronically in accordance with legal regulations and the Regulations, or with whom an Agreement for the provision of electronic services may be concluded.
- 5. Personal data (GDPR) In accordance with art. 13 REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation)) Nire informs that:

- 2. Personal data will not be disclosed to entities other than those authorized by law. The personal data provided by the User will be processed only for the purpose for which they were collected, i.e. sending an advertisement, preparing and presenting a commercial offer or concluding a contract.
- 3. The User has the right to request Nire access to his personal data, rectification, deletion or limitation of processing, the right to object to the processing and the right to transfer data by submitting the appropriate request to Nire. The request may be submitted in writing to the address of Nire Sp. z o.o. street Rejonowa 29, 05-552 Kolonia Mrokowska or via e-mail to the address kontakt@nire.eu. Requests for the processing of personal data are available to data subjects at the headquarters of Nire.
- 4. The user also has the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority at any time. 5. Providing data by the User is voluntary and / or may result from legal provisions.
- 6. Personal data will be processed to the extent and for the purpose for which they were collected.
- 7. The list of entities cooperating with Nire entrusted with the processing of personal data is available at the company's headquarters.
- 8. Nire uses the technical measures required by the provisions on the protection of personal data to prevent the collection and modification of personal data sent electronically by unauthorized persons.

§ 4

Cookies

- 1. Used by Nire Cookies are completely safe for the User's device. First of all, it is not possible for viruses or other unwanted software or malware to enter Users' Devices in this way. These files allow to recognize the software used by the User and adapt the Website to each of them individually. Cookies usually contain the name of the domain from which they originate, their storage period on the Device and the assigned value.
- 2. Nire, like other websites, uses cookies on its website. We divide these files according to their durability into long-term (permanent) and short-term (session). Session cookies are stored in the

browser only until it is closed and persistent remain on the User's device until they are deleted.

This mechanism does not provide the possibility to download any personal data or any confidential information from the User's Device.

3. Each User may limit and / or disable cookies access to their Device. Using this option does not constitute the inability to use the Website, it only prevents the operation of functions that require cookies.

§ 5

Use of cookies

Nire uses its own and external cookies to:

- 1. adapt your website to your needs by recognizing your device to be able to properly display the website, including keep its full functionality and facilitate its use; 1
- 2. . statistics (analysis and research), audience monitoring to know how Users use the website, which allows improving their content and structure;
- 3. marketing, tailoring the content of the newsletter to the needs of the User;
- 4. detect fraud and ensure website security.
- 5. collecting statistical data using analytical tools, e.g. Google Adwords or Google Analytics.
- 6. Use of interactive functions to increase website viewership through social networking sites such as Facebook, Twitter, Youtube, Instagram, Google +. § 6 Conditions for storage and / or access through Cookies 26. Nire informs that the User can change cookie settings independently at any time, setting the rules for storing and accessing Cookies to the User's Device. The User can make these changes in the web browser settings or by using the service configuration. The User may change the settings in such a way as to first of all automatically block cookies in the web browser settings or to inform each time about their placing on the User's device. Detailed data on the methods and principles of handling cookies are available in the settings of web browsers.

7. At any time, the User may delete Cookies using the features available in the web browser he uses.

8. Setting restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functions available on
